Behçet's disease (BD) is a multisystemic chronic inflammatory disease of unknown etiology. It is characterized by recurrent oral and genital aphthous lesions, as well as skin, eye, joint, gastrointestinal and central nervous system manifestations. This retrospective study was designed to evaluate the clinical and

therapeutic features of a series of 32 patients with BD from 1 January 1998 to 1 January 2002. Diagnosis was based on international criteria. Disease activity was measured by a validated rating scale based on the Behçet's score (BS). The main clinical symptoms were oral aphthosis (75%), cutaneous lesions (66%), genital lesions (53%), central nervous system (50%), eye lesions (43%), joint involvement (33%) and digestive lesions (27%). Most patients were also overweight (53%) and systemic corticotherapy was the most common treatment (84%). The median follow-up was 29 months. Six patients (19%) did not receive corticosteroids during the follow-up. Two patients (6%) required immunosuppressors. Oral, genital and skin lesions were controlled by a variable combination of corticotherapy and immunosuppressors. This study suggests that corticosteroids are not necessary in most patients with BD and may in fact increase the risk of infections and adverse effects.(1) Field of the Invention The present invention relates to a solid electrolytic capacitor and a process for producing the same.
